Here are a few more bits of information to help you **READ to SUCCEED...** 

- READING with your child at any age K-3 is *highly encouraged* and very rewarding!
- Picture books count as one book.
- List the title of the book on a line on the flag with a parent initial or signature.
- Parents can sign one flag when completed or each line- whatever you prefer.
- PLEASE be sure first and last name, grade and teacher are listed on each page.
- CHAPTER BOOKS- each chapter counts as 1 book OR you can **challenge** yourself and just count chapter books as 1!
- The title of a chapter book can be listed then just circle the amount of lines that correlate with the number of chapters... 10 chapters-circle ten numbers- whatever works best for you!
- Books that have very short chapters, diary entries, graphic novels, poetry, or joke books, etc. 40 pages should count as 1 book.
- ALL students that have reached the GOAL by the end of FEBRUARY will be recognized at a school wide assembly!
- Extra forms can be found on the school website on the library page.
- If this form is lost and you do not print out another one...recording the titles on notebook paper is absolutely fine.
- The books you choose to read should be for your own interest or pleasure... NOT school assignments/homework.
- Hand this paper to your teacher or the library as soon as you have reached the GOAL!
